ADDENDUM NO. 01

 - Item "j (a)"- Organizational Chart for the contract to be bid should indicate the personnel assigned to the project. The project engineer to be assigned to oversee the project should not be the owner of the Contractor.
 - Other documentary requirements
 - Item "q"- deletedItem "r"- deleted

II. Section III-Bid Data Sheet

- ITB Clause 10.4 -"Key Personnel" has been changed to read as:
 - Project Engineer: Civil Engineer/Architect- Must have managed/supervised a completed project involving civil or structural works with 40 hrs. training in Occupational Safety and Health with certificate form DOLE. However, if the Project Engineer does not have the abovementioned training certificate, a Safety Officer must be assigned to the project.
- ITB Clause 20- "Post- Qualification documents" have been changed to read as:
 - Item No. 1- 2020 Income and Business Tax returns filed and paid through electronic filing and payment system (eFPS). If manually filed, attach the BIR Memorandum Circular allowing that mode of submission.

III. Section V-Special Conditions of the Contract

GCC Clause 14- Progress Payments has been changed to read as:

- Item No. 3 and 5- Retention Money
 - In lieu of 10% of the contract amount as retention money, a special bank guarantee equivalent to 10% of the contract price may be submitted by the bidder. The bidder may also submit a Surety Bond which is one of the acceptable forms of bid, performance and warranty securities, provided it is callable upon demand and accompanied by an Insurance Commission Certificate stating that the surety and/or insurance company is authorized to issue such security.

- 2. Second/Full payment shall be equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the work accomplished as certified by the end-user. Payment shall be processed upon submission of the following:
 - Letter request of the Contractor for the release of the payment for work accomplished
 - Breakdown of work accomplished as validated and certified by PICC Representative
 - Photographs of work accomplished
 - Key plan highlighting work accomplished
 - As-Built Plan in soft and hard copy. The hard copy shall be in A3 bond size, three (3) copies signed by the CONTRACTOR and PICC authorized representative. The soft copy shall be saved in a USB.
- 3. Progress payments (first and second/final payments) shall be subject to the following:
 - Ten percent (10%) of the contract amount as retention money. The total "retention money" shall be due for release upon final acceptance of the works. In lieu of 10% of the contract amount as retention money, a special bank guarantee equivalent to 10% of the contract price may be submitted by the bidder. The bidder may also submit a Surety Bond which is one of the acceptable forms of bid, performance and warranty securities, provided it is callable upon demand and accompanied by an Insurance Commission Certificate stating that the surety and/or insurance company is authorized to issue such security
- 4. The PICC representative shall check the contractor's request for payment and certify the amount to be paid to the contractor as progress payments. Materials and equipment delivered on the site but not completely put in place shall not be included for payment.
- 5. The PICC shall deduct the following from the certified gross amounts to be paid to the contractor's progress payments.
 - Cumulative value of the works previously certified and paid for.
 - Portion of the advance payment to be recouped for the month.
 - 10% as Retention money
 - Amount to cover the third party liabilities
 - Amount to cover the uncorrected discovered defects in the works.

	• In lieu of 10% of the contract amount as retention money, a special bank guarantee equivalent to 10% of the contract price may be submitted by the bidder.
