TERMS OF REFERENCE

I. Scope of Works & Technical Specifications

	2. Any work that may affect the operation and security	

measures of PICC shall be coordinated properly and shall be done in accordance with the PICC' approved schedule.

- 3. All metal supports, hangers, brackets, clamps and bases of the SRS equipment must be painted with epoxy primer gray, one (1) coat and two (2) coats epoxy paint gray finish.
- 4. Submit sample/s of materials to be used for approval prior to installation.
- 5. Exercise good/proper workers' practices in the workplace to ensure safe and on-time completion of the project.
- 6. Cost of restoration for damaged equipment and any other PICC property due to negligence and/or poor workmanship of worker/s assigned by the Contractor for the subject project shall be borne by the Contractor.
- 7. Welding works or any "hot works" requirement of the project must be coordinated with the Project-in-Charge and seek approval from the MSD Assistant Director and TSD Director prior to implementation and that, a personal fire extinguisher/s should always be stationed in the area for emergency purpose.
- Electric meter shall be provided and installed by the contractor for electrical equipment's power consumption monitoring/recording. Said consumption will be charged to the contractor using prevailing power rate on the duration of work for the project.
- 9. Contractor must submit individual Police/NBI clearance for the personnel to be assigned and that they must be in uniform with IDs throughout the duration of the project.
- 10. The Contractor should free the PICC and its personnel from and against all liabilities arising from injuries or liabilities to persons or damages to property occasioned by any act or omissions by the Contractor including any and all expenses, legal or otherwise which may be incurred by PICC and its personnel in the defense of any claim, action or suit.

Statement of Compliance

Bidders must state here either "Comply" or "Not Comply" against each of the individual parameters of each Specification stating the corresponding performance parameter of the equipment offered.

II. Performance Bond:

III. Warranty period:

Two (2) years warranty for workmanship and materials/equipment supplied by the Contractor.

The period for correction of defects in the warranty period is seven (7) calendar days upon receipt of notice from PICC project-in-charge.

IV. Payment

Payment shall be released in full within four (4) weeks after final acceptance by PICC or its representative of the Contractor's completed work, and submission of billing and complete supporting documents by Contractor as follows:

- 1. Invoice
- 2. Payment is subject to retention of five percent (5%) of the contract amount referred to as the "retention money". The said amount shall be released after the lapse of the warranty period.

V. Withholding Tax:

The PICC shall withhold and deduct the corresponding tax from the amount shown in the awardee's invoice subject to the provision of applicable laws.
