ADDENDUM NO. 01

This Addendum is issued to amend/revise certain provisions of the Bid Documents for the above-captioned procurement. Said amendments are as follows:

- I. Section V- Special Conditions of the Contract have been revised to read as follows:
 - GCC Clause 2.2
 - Payment
 - Full Payment shall be processed within twenty (20) working days from the receipt of the invoice, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations of the PICC.
 - GCC Clause 5
 - Warranty
 - The warranty period is one (1) year after acceptance by the PICC authorized representative of the project.

The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by either retention money in an amount equivalent to five percent (5%) of the total contract price, or a special bank guarantee equivalent to five percent (5%) of the total contract price. (Note: GPPB RES NO. 30-2017).

The said amount shall be released after the lapse of the warranty period or after consumption thereof, provided, that the supplies delivered are free from patent and latent defects and all the conditions imposed under the contract have been fully met.

 - Work shall be completed within sixty (60) calendar days from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed
