ADDENDUM NO. 01

This Addendum is issued to amend/revise certain provisions of the Bid Documents for the above-captioned procurement. Said amendments are as follows:

- I. Section III- Bid Data Sheet have been revised to read as:
 - ITB Clause 20.2
 - g. List of escalator projects within the last ten (10) years detailing the name of clients, completion dates and the contract price, contact person and the telephone numbers.
- II. Section V- Special Conditions of the Contract have been revised to read as:
 - GCC Clause 5
 - Warranty

One (1) year warranty for workmanship and materials/equipment supplied by the Contractor after final completion and acceptance of the project. This means that a part or some parts, which will giveway within the warranty period, shall be replaced by the Contractor at no extra cost to PICC. The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by, at the Contractor's option, either retention money in an amount equivalent to five percent (5%) of the Contract amount or a Special Bank Guarantee bond equivalent to (five percent 5%) of the total Contract amount. Said warranty obligation shall be released only after the expiration of warranty period, however, the same will be forfeited by PICC as part of payment for any damage of surroundina equipment components/parts attributable contractor's negligence or poor workmanship during dismantling of the escalators, hauling, installation, testing and commissioning period.

As part of the one-year general warranty, the contractor must conduct monthly check-up and servicing of the subject escalators with proper service records and reports for submission to PICC-Mechanical Services Division.

The period for correction of defects is seven (7) calendar days upon receipt of notice from PICC project-in-charge.

The contractor shall be granted extension of completion time for additional work/s not covered herein due to any work delays attributable to PICC. In case of delay in the required completion time or delivery period, inclusive of duly granted time extensions if any, the Contractor shall be liable for damages for the delay and shall pay the PICC for liquidated damages an amount equivalent to 1/10th of one percent (1%) of the total value of the project for each day of delay until such time the project is finally completed and accepted by PICC. Said penalty on delay shall be charged to any amount due to the Contractor, or in the absence or insufficiency thereof, from the performance bond/security. In case of insufficiency of the bond, the Contractor shall pay the balance to PICC upon notice.
