Bidders should have completed, within the last ten (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the abovementioned requirement. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from the *PICC-BAC* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by prospective bidders starting August 7, 2024 from the given address and website(s) below and *upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php17,500.00)*. A bidder shall present its proof of payment for the fee *by furnishing the PICC-BAC a copy of the Official Receipt*.
- 6. The *PICC-BAC* will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on August 14, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. Function Room B, 2nd Floor Secretariat Building, PICC and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting via Zoom/Google Meet, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below, on or before August 29, 2024 at 9:30 a.m. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on August 29, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. at the given address below. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

- 10. The PICC reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

	1.1.2. Landing Platforms – The Top and Bottom Platforms where the ends of the Escalator Trusses are anchored should be of a rigid and non-skid metal floor plate, flushed and hinged or bolted to allow easy access/maintenance. Furthermore, it should have a comb plate which properly mesh with the cleats on the Steps to minimize the gap between the Escalator Steps and Landing as well as to prevent objects from becoming caught in between.	
	1.1.3. Steps — Solid, one-piece, die cast aluminum, cleated (ribbed appearance) with comb-like protection that properly mesh with the cleats of the Top/Bottom Platforms and of the succeeding Steps of the Escalator. Steps Should have a yellow sides and back linings for demarcation.	
	1.1.4. Comb Plates – Should be made of aluminum alloy or an oil-filled cast Polyamide (IGOPAS) bearing the natural yellow color of the material, provides a good visual warning of the transition between moving parts and fixed parts that would contribute to increase passenger safety.	
	1.1.5. Trusses - Must be of a well-designed rigid metal structure to support/carry the weight of the straight track section of the Escalator.	



- 1.1.6. Handrails Requirements on the following four (4) distinct sections of the Handrail:
 - 1.1.6.1. The Slider The center section of the handrail should be a layer of a synthetic textile.
 - 1.1.6.2. The Tension Member It should consists of either steel cable or floor steel tape to provide tensile strength and flexibility of the handrail.
 - 1.1.6.3. The Inner Component It should be made of a chemically treated rubber well-designed to prevent the inner layers from separation/fast deterioration.
 - 1.1.6.4. The Outer Component/Cover It should be made of a blend of synthetic polymers and rubber to resist degradation due to environmental conditions, mechanical wear and vandalism.
- 1.1.7. Rollers must be of a well-designed material/component, properly formed for safer and proper adaptation with the moving escalator parts/components and to prevent premature wearing of the rubberized handrail
- 1.1.8 Sensors for Automatic Operation Proposed escalators should be fitted with sensors for the detection of passenger traffic/ usage requirement for operating speed variations that would result to a much lower/reduced power consumption.
- 1.1.9. Automatic Safety Stopping Devices Escalators should also be equipped with the following automatic Stopping Devices /System that should immediately deactivate the Escalator in case of emergency:
 - 1.1.9.1. Emergency Stop Button
 - 1.1.9.2. Step Motion Safety Device
 - 1.1.9.3. Overload/Over current/Open or reversed Phase Detection Device
 - 1.1.9.4. Speed Governor
 - 1.1.9.5. Electromagnetic Brake
 - 1.1.9.6. Drive Train Safety Device
 - 1.1.9.7. Handrail/Guard Safety Device
 - 1.1.9.8. Step Level Device

- 1.1.9.9. Skirt Guard Safety Device
- 1.1.9.10. Comb-Step Safety Switch/Impact Device

- 1.1.10. Enclosure of the Escalators Inner sidings of the existing structured concrete enclosure should be plastered to conform with required clearance with the escalator sidings and finished similar to the existing outer side finish for aesthetics
- 1.1.11. Electrical Installation electric wirings, printed circuit boards, overload protection, contactors and relays, circuit breakers, transformer, sensors, stopping devices and other requirement to ensure proper safe and free from static operation. Power/Control Transformer will be provided by the Contractor it indeed necessary.

1.2. Main Features:

- 1.2.1. Heavy-Duty Subject Escalators must be designed to handle heavy passenger traffic during peak hours.
- 1.2.2. An Inverter-type Escalator's speed will be reduced by an inverter-type motor that enables energy-saving automatic low-speed stand-by to reduce power consumption as needed.
- 1.2.3. Automatic safety stopping devices and other manually operated manual stop.
- 1.2.4. Starting the Escalator Key operated to prevent unauthorized use of the equipment.
- 2. Mobilization and delivery of all appropriate equipment, tools, materials and personnel necessary for the project.
- 3. Install board up/safety enclosure and provide safety signage/devices in accordance to the Construction Safety and Health Standard in securing the working area.
- 4. Dismantle existing escalators serving 3/F to 4/F Secretariat Building and haul all dismantled escalator parts from the dismantling area to the PICC's designated storage location within the PICC premises. De-



energize power supply of the subject escalators with the following technical specifications before the dismantling works:

- 5. Upon the complete dismantling of the subject existing escalators for replacement, Contractor shall verify all dimensions and clearances of the area where the escalator will be installed to ensure that the new escalators will properly fit and be installed rigidly into the original concrete structure/casing of the said old escalators.
- 6. Deliver to site the subject brand new replacement escalators along with its Product Testing Certificate, Certificate of Origin, Inspection Certificate, etc. Contractor is advised to deliver the new escalator/s when they are ready for installation since PICC has no available space for equipment storage. Storage fee for the new escalators, which must be outside of PICC prior to delivery, shall be shouldered by the Contractor.
- 7. Coordinate properly with the PICC Assistant Director of Mechanical Services Division or his representative the schedule of equipment delivery to avoid inconvenience to the PICC personnel, tenants, guest and the public.
- 8. The Contractor shall provide hoisting mechanisms/equipment such as Telescopic crane, weight pads, spreaders etc.
- 9. Install the above-mentioned escalator units perfectly centered on the opening/width of the concrete casing enclosure for aesthetic balance for their proper operation at 3/F to 4/F Delegation Building. All works herewith shall include all mechanical and electrical works. Contractor shall also perform any civil works/retro-fitting works that may arise during the installation works. Gaps for concrete plastering must be filled and flattened from the bottom to top portion.
- 10. Provide/install stainless steel plate as side wall/gap cladding as well as SS metal barriers in between escalators and the concrete enclosure wallings.



- 11. Testing and commissioning works such as Full Load Run Test, Speed Test, Temperature Rise Test, Safety Stopping Device Test and other necessary test to ensure safe and proper operation of the subject escalators.
- 12. Restoration of all damaged/affected areas during the dismantling and/or installation works. Restore all damaged/affected areas to its original form/specifications. Cost of restoration shall be borne by the Contractor.
- 13. Turnover the two (2) units new escalators in good order and operating condition complete with "Caution" sign and other needed signages. Submit warranty certificate, testing and commissioning data turn over/completion reports and other necessary documents upon completion and acceptance of the project.
- 14. Demobilization.

II. CONDITIONS:

- 1. The Contractor must conduct site survey and inspection.
- 2. The Contractor shall provide a sufficient number of safety personnel for the duration of the work. Safety personnel shall monitor the Contractor's personnel as they carry out the work and be responsible for hazard assessment, first aid, safety watch, spotter duties, gas monitoring, hot works monitoring, fall protection and etc. Assigned personnel shall be in their Contractor-supplied Personnel Protective Equipment (PPEs), and comply other Health/Safety Regulations
- 3. The Contractor shall install safety signs and/or devices and display it in designated and/or conspicuous areas for public information and general safety.
- 4. "Hot works" will be carried-out by a highly skilled welder along with his/her safety watcher and that a personal fire extinguisher/s should always be stationed in the area for emergency purpose.
- 5. The Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining and paying for any mechanical/electrical permits from the City of Pasay and importation permits required for this project.
- All works and requirements not expressly included in the scope of work, but are absolutely necessary or are standard practices or requirements in similar installations, shall be considered integral part of the scope of work.
- 7. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing all miscellaneous hardware needed to make the system operational.
- 8. Contractor shall guarantee that the installation of new equipment shall fit/adopt to the existing condition opening of the machine enclosure pit and as a fitting replacement for the existing and old escalators in terms of efficiency and durability
- The Contractor, shall be responsible for supervising and directing the work, using the best highly skilled technicians and mechanics. All works and inspections shall be conducted by the Contractor's skilled

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- personnel and engineers and will be accompanied by the PICC Assistant Director of Mechanical Services Division or his representative.
- 10. The Contractor shall ensure that all deliveries and materials to be used in the project are all brand new and presented first to the PICC for prior approval before its actual installation. Rigging/hauling lifting methodology, system design and materials must be submitted prior to start of work for approval of TSD-MSD
- 11. Any work that may affect the operation and security measures of PICC shall be coordinated properly and shall be done in accordance with the PICC' approved schedule.
- 12. The contractor shall report to PICC on or before the bidding, any perceived or evident condition that would prevent him from performing first class work.
- 13. Power supply for welding works shall be provided by the PICC. However, the Contractor shall provide sub watt-hour meter for the purpose of monitoring the power consumption that will be charged to the Contractor. A fire extinguisher must be provided/stationed near the hot works of the Contractor.

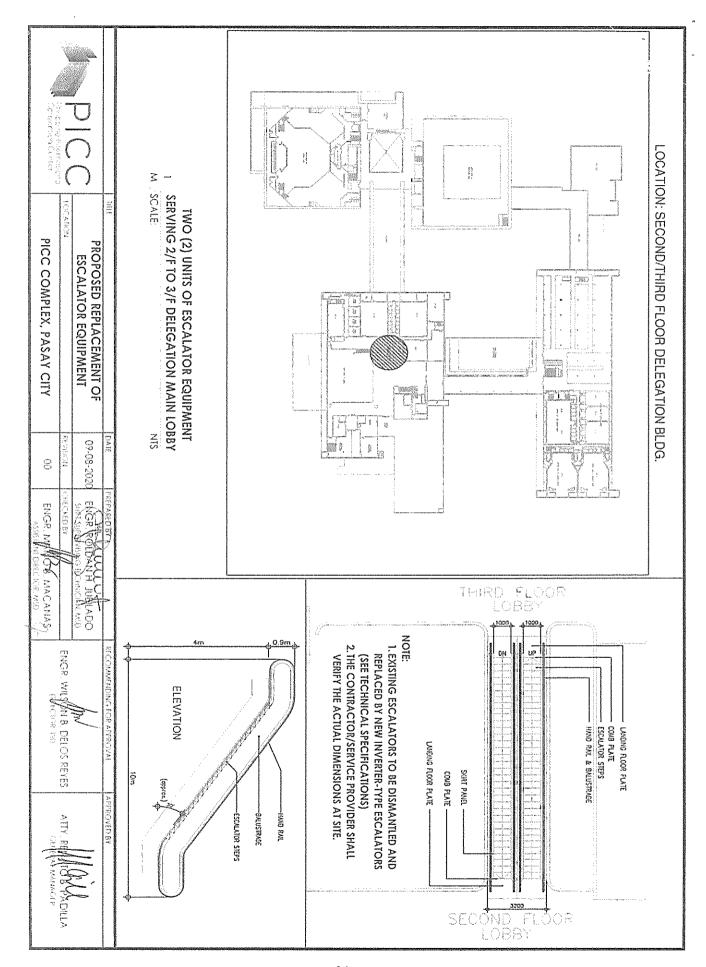
The PICC shall withhold and deduct the corresponding tax from the amount shown in the awardee's invoice subject to the provision of applicable laws and/or obligation.
